

Communication and Language

In our continuous provision we will be providing opportunities for:

- Listening to stories,
- Maintaining focus on a chosen activity,
- Responding to the ideas of others,
- Introducing storylines and narratives into their activities,
- Using talk to link statements and stick to a main theme.

Physical Development

- We will be taking part in daily 'Dough disco' sessions to help improve our fine motor skills.
- We will be concentrating on forming letters in the correct way and using tools such as scissors with increasing control.
- We will be taking part in gymnastics and multi skills activities during our PE lessons.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- In our continuous provision we will be providing opportunities for:
- Developing confidence when speaking to others,
- Trying new activities,
- Working together,
- Taking account of what others are saying,
- Explaining own knowledge and understanding.

Literacy

We will be continuing to learn letter sounds through our phonic programme 'Letters and Sounds.' This will help us to read and write CVC words and simple sentences.

We will be sharing stories such as 'The Gingerbread Man.'

We will be learning to retell stories by using repeating phrases and actions and by making our own story maps.

We will be looking at non-fiction books to find out information about different types of transport and writing our own non-fiction report.

We will be continuing to learn rhymes and poems.

Class 1 Spring 2020

Our topic in Class 1 this term is 'On the move.'

The children's interests will continually be used to inform the direction which our topic takes.

Our whole school topic this term is 'Frozen Planet.' The children will participate in mixed age group activities as well as focusing on age-appropriate tasks. They will have the opportunity to share their achievements with each other.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be learning new songs and how to use different instruments.

We will be learning about our environment. We will be learning about the changes in the different seasons.

We will be learning about different types of vehicles. We will be comparing past and present forms of transport.

We will be looking at how things move and ways to change this.

We will be using the IWB, laptops and iPads.

Maths

We will be learning to recognise numbers up to 20 and say which is one more or one less than a number.

We will be starting to understand what adding and subtracting means and solve problems using different methods.

We will be comparing and ordering items by length, height, weight and capacity.

We will be learning the names of 2D and 3D shapes and where they can be found in the environment. We will be comparing the shapes and sorting them into different groups.
