English

In English the children will be exploring descriptive writing, focusing on openings and endings. They will have the opportunity to develop their poetry writing and write a recount. The children will be using the 'Talk for Writing' approach. They will also continue to read a range of interesting texts in guided reading sessions.

Geography

During the term the children will be looking at Houses around the World. They will be locating countries on the globe but mainly focusing on India. They will also be comparing houses and giving reasons to why families live in similar/ different ways to how we live in our homes.

PSHE

Our theme this term is 'Good to be me'. Each child has the opportunity to put forward their views n how to improve their schools and the local community during Class Council meetings.

Art and DT

In Art this term our whole school topic is 'texture'. The children will be looking at conveying a variety of messages and emotions.

In DT they will be constructing their own house for the Three Little Pigs by designing, making and evaluating.

Mathematics

In Maths the children will develop their understanding of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division and will apply these skills in problem-solving activities. They will also be learning about fractions and measurement.

The children will be engaging in lots of games and challenges that will begin to deepen their thinking in Maths.

Science

In Science our topic is 'Materials'. The children will start the topic by identifying and comparing the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard for different uses. Also they will be investigating how things move on different surfaces.

Our whole school topic this term is Frozen Planet'. The children will participate in mixed age group activities as well as focusing on age-appropriate tasks. They will have the opportunity to share their achievements with each other.

Religious Education

Music
