The children will be using focused reading comprehension skills in our weekly guided reading sessions. In writing, we will continue with regular practise of handwriting. We will also work on word classes and higher order punctuation. We will continue to use a cross-curricula approach to our writing and will produce both fiction and non-fiction writing. We will also

focus on Y3/4 spellings.

Mathematics

Throughout this term, the children will continue to develop their maths skills through regular practise of basic skills, focused sessions on developing new skills and a range of problem-solving activities. They will be undertaking activities which will develop their knowledge of multiplication & division, fractions and decimals as well as topics such as money and measures.
