Dear Parents/Guardians,

I hope you have enjoyed the Summer holidays and your child has been looking forward to starting school. We are looking forward to meeting them!

As we start the term, I thought that I would take the opportunity to inform you of what will be going on in Class 1. I have attached the curriculum overview for the Autumn Term. We have a very exciting term planned for them!

Your child will be bringing home a story book in their book bags, this is for you to read with your child. Please sign your child's reading diary once you have read the book. We will check daily and change these as soon as they've been read. In a couple of weeks, your child will then start bringing home a phonics reading book and a set of keywords for them to read themselves. There will be more information about this closer to the time.

PE will take place on a Monday and Wednesday this term. On a Monday they will be taught by our PE specialist Mr Webb. It is important that you bring your child's PE kit in this week please.

Forest Schools sessions will take place on a Tuesday afternoon during the second half of the Autumn term. These will start on Tuesday 2nd November and will finish on Tuesday 7th December. A separate letter with more information about Forest Schools will be sent out nearer to the time.

Please can you make sure that your child brings in their painting shirt and wellies if they haven't already done so. Please can you also ensure that you have brought back all of the forms which you were given before the Summer holidays.

It is important that your child brings their book bag, waterproof coat and a bottle filled with water to school every day.

You will soon be receiving an email which will enable you to access your child's learning journey on Tapestry. Each week there will be observations posted of your child for you to see what they have been learning in school.
