

English

In English the children will be exploring many texts chosen to develop descriptive writing. They will have the opportunity to develop wow words, openers, linking words and punctuation. The children will be using the 'Talk for Writing' approach. They will also continue to read a range of interesting texts in guided reading sessions.

Mathematics

In maths the children will develop their understanding of place value and apply their knowledge and skills of the Four Rules. They will apply these skills in problem-solving activities. They will also be learning about money.

The children will be engaging in lots of games and challenges that will begin to deepen their thinking in maths.

Science

In Science our topic will be 'Seasonal Changes'. The children will start the topic by finding out about different seasons and how to describe them. They will then find out about how animals and humans are affected by the seasons.

Geography

Our topic this term will be 'The Four Seasons'. The children will find out how the seasons are linked with the month of the year. Then find out what the weather is like during each season.

Our settling in topic will be 'The Circus!'

Our whole school topic this term is 'World Food'. The children will participate in a range of activities exploring and tasting foods from around the World.

History

Class 2 will be learning about 'Toys Past & Present' this term. They will use a wide range of sources to learn how to describe toys throughout different eras, and the similarities and differences to those you find today.

Religious Education

During this term the children will be learning about what it means to belong to a faith community and what Christians believe God is like.

Physical Education

The children will have Mr Webb for P.E on a Monday. They will be focusing on dance and 'Hit, Catch, Run' this term.

On a Wednesday they will have PE with Ms Evans focusing on gymnastics and 'Attack, Shoot, Defend'.

PSHE

Each child has the opportunity to put forward their views on how to improve their school and the local community during Class Council meetings. The two themes we will be covering are 'Being Me in My World' and 'Celebrating Difference'.

Music

In music the children will be exploring pulse and rhythm through singing games and percussion instruments. They will also develop their performing skills when presenting to the class.

Art and Design & D.T

Our topic will be 'Formal Elements of Art'. The children will be looking at shape, line and colour. During D.T. the children will design and create a moving storybook.

Computing

The children will be learning about using computers and the internet safely. They will also be using apps to support their learning in class, including programming the 'Beebots'.

How you can help

Please continue to read and share books with your child every night, when possible. Keywords will be assessed every week so please can you help your child learn them. The children are learning their 2 and 10 times tables at present so extra support at home would help. KIRF sheets will be provided half termly to develop fluency. We ask that you also continue to help your child with learning to tell the time and offer them experiences with money. You could encourage your child to find relevant books on our topics for them to share in class. You may also have some artefacts, pictures or books of your own that they could bring into school.
