

English

In English, we will be writing a range of fiction and non-fiction texts and will continue with regular practise of handwriting. We will also work on word classes and higher order punctuation. The children will be using focused reading comprehension skills in our weekly guided reading sessions.

Design and Technology

In D&T, we will be revisiting how circuits can be adapted to suit different purposes and applying this knowledge to design and create electronic greeting cards.

Geography

In geography, Class 4 will learn all about Scandinavia exploring the location, features and culture of Norway, Sweden and Denmark. We will find out how the climates differ in various areas of Scandinavia, explore spectacular scenery and learn about the culture and lifestyle in Scandinavian countries.

Music

In music, we will learn to identify the pitch and rhythm of written notes and then experiment with notating their compositions in different ways to help develop their understanding of staff notation.

French

We will be continuing to develop our knowledge of French culture and language.

Mathematics

Throughout this term, the children will continue to develop their numeracy skills through regular practise of basic skills, focused sessions on developing new skills and a range of problem-solving activities. The children will be undertaking activities which will develop their knowledge of place value and the four operations. We will be continuing to consolidate our times tables knowledge up to 12×12 .

Class 4 Autumn Term 2021 Vikings vs Anglo-Saxons

This term our topic is exploring the Vikings and the Anglo-Saxons. We will be working as history detectives to piece together the fragments from the past, as well as exploring Scandinavia in our Geography lessons.

Our whole school topic this term is 'World Food Week'. The children will participate in mixed age group activities as well as focusing on age-appropriate tasks.

Art and Design

Our art topic this term is exploring formal elements of architecture. We will learn how to draw from observation, create a print and draw from different perspectives. The children will also learn about the role of an architect and are challenged to consider why houses look the way they do and if there is scope to change and improve them.

Religious Education

Our two questions we will be exploring this term are: 'What does it mean for Christians to believe that God is holy and loving?' and 'What does it mean to be a Muslim in Britain today?'

Physical Education

In P.E this term we will be playing hockey, tag rugby, netball and football.

How you can help

Please support your child at home by reading for 20 minutes every night and signing their reading diaries ready. Part of their homework is to have a quick recall of multiplication and division facts up to 12×12 , playing 10 ticks and Stick & Split daily will help improve their recall speed. In addition to their homework, you could encourage your child to find some books about our topics in the library or find some relevant information on the internet. Science

Our science topics this term is Living Things and their Habitats, learning all about different life cycles. We will also be learning about, and celebrating, Great British Scientists.

History

Class 4 will go on a fascinating journey back in time as they find out about the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the kingdom of England and how England became a unified country. We will explore where the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings came from, how they fought for territory and power, and how their fighting ultimately led to the kingdom of England we know today.

Computing

In computing, we will be exploring search engines using keywords and phrases, identifying inaccurate information and learning page rank.

PSHE

In PSHE, we will be continuing with our 'Jigsaw' lessons. Our focus for the half terms are 'Being Me in My World' and 'Celebrating Difference'.
