English

The children will be focusing on English comprehension skills throughout this term. We will be looking at a range of texts and developing our retrieval, inference and summary skills. We will also be exploring a range of writing styles. These will sometimes link to our topic or English text and will include both fictional and nonfictional writing. There will be a continual focus on spelling, punctuation and grammar.

Geography

We will be learning about the Arctic in Geography in the second half of the term. This will explore various elements of the Arctic and link to animals and habitats in Science.

Mathematics

Throughout this term, the children will continue to develop their maths skills through regular practise of basic skills, focused sessions on developing new skills and a range of problem-solving activities. They will be engaging in practical, hands-on mathematical experiences that will support their understanding of new concepts. We will be covering a range of topics in a variety of fun and exciting lessons.

Class 2 Summer Term 2022

Our whole school topic day this term is 'The Queen's Platinum Jubilee'.

Our whole school topic week this term is 'World of Water.'

Design Technology

The children will be exploring structures in DT this term. They will be developing their DT skills through researching, designing, making and evaluating their projects.

Art and Design

This term in Art and Design we are going to be working on Art and Design skills. The children will have the opportunity to design their artwork which will link to their topic and develop their skills to produce a final piece.

Music

The children will be looking at space music, linking to their computing and history topic. The children will be composing and performing their pieces.

Religious Education

RE this term will be looking at The Christian belief of how the world was made. In the second half of the term, we will be learning how we should care for the world and others.

PSHE

In PSHE this term we will be looking at relationships and changing me. The children will have lots of opportunities to talk and ask questions about a range of PSHE topics.

Science

We will be looking at Animals this term. Living things and their habitats explores hibernation, life cycles, animal families and food chains. The children will have lots of opportunities to work scientifically, perform investigations and collect data. This will link nicely to the Arctic topic after half term.

History

In the first half of the term, we are going to be looking at Explorers. We will be exploring historical explorers such as Amelia Earhart and Christopher Columbus, as well as referencing some recent and local explorers.

Computing

We will be looking at programming a rocket to go to the moon this half term. The children will be exploring coding and programming with a link to their music and
