

English

In English, the children will be exploring many texts chosen to develop descriptive writing. They will have the opportunity to develop vocabulary, openers, conjunctions, and punctuation. The children will be using the 'Talk for Writing' approach where they will be introduced to a range of interesting texts.

Physical Education

The children will have Adriano for P.E on a Wednesday and Miss Roberts on a Friday. They will be focusing on the skills of running, throwing, jumping plus send and return.

Geography

In Geography, the children will be learning about Life in the City. They will learn what a city is and identify some major capital cities around the world. The children will explore the human and physical features of a city and explore the symbols used to create maps.

PSHE

Our themes this term are Dreams and Goals, and Healthy Me.

Music

In Music, the children will be learning how to perform actions to music with a sense of beat and to respond to musical signals and musical themes using movement. Children will develop awareness of duration and the ability to move slowly to music and will have a chance to create art work, drawing freely and imaginatively in response to a piece of music. Our first unit will be Composing Music Inspired by Birdsong.

Mathematics

Our maths topics this term include: Addition & Subtraction, Multiplication & Division, Shape, Money, and Length & Height. They will learn through a mixture of pictorial, abstract and written methods, with access to concrete resources to support their learning.

Our whole school topic weeks this term include Children's Mental Health Week beginning on the 3rd of February, and British Science Week throughout the 7th to the 16th of March.

Design and Technology

In D&T, the children will be exploring types of windmills, how they work and their key features before designing and constructing a windmill model.

Religious Education

During this term the children will be learning why Easter is important to Christians.

Computing

Our topic this term is, 'Technology Around Us'. We will learn all about the world of technology through exploring the difference between technology and information technology, and how technology has changed over time.

Art and Design

In Art this term we will be looking at the artist, L.S. Lowry. The children will have the opportunity to explore the life and work of Lowry and his famous works about city life.

Science

Our topics this term include 'Growth and Survival', where the children will learn all about the human life cycle and the things all animals need to grow, thrive, and survive.

We will also be exploring materials - identifying, classifying, and describing the everyday materials around us. The unit will allow for Scientific Enquiry and hands-on opportunities.

History

In History, Class 2 will be finding out about the Great Fire of London! They will learn about London in 1666, the causes and consequences of the fire and lasting impact. We will be creating little artworks along the way to help with our knowledge, understanding and enjoyment of this exciting topic!

How you can help

Please continue to read and share books with your child every day, when possible. Spellings and keywords will be assessed each week so please can you help your child learn them. The keywords are tricky words that the children will need to learn by sight, so regular practice will help them become fluent in reading them.

We ask that you help your child with learning to tell the time and offer them experiences with money.
