

## English

In English, the children will be exploring descriptive writing. The children will be using the 'Talk for Writing' approach. They will continue to read a range of interesting texts in guided reading sessions.

## Religious Education

During this term, the children will focus on two key questions: 'What is the good news Christians believe Jesus brings?' and 'What makes some places sacred to believers?'

## Physical Education

The children will have Adriano for P.E on a Wednesday and Miss Roberts on a Friday. They will be focusing on hitting, catching and running.

## Geography

Our topic for this term is 'Map Makers'. The children will be learning how to use compass points to navigate around a map. They will then design their own map, including basic symbols in a key.

## Computing

The children will continue to learn about online safety and will have the opportunity to use and explore the program Scratch Jr.

## Music

In music, the children will be exploring topics linked to their history topic of 'Seaside Holidays'.

## Mathematics

In maths, the children will develop their fractions, time, statistics, and positional and directional knowledge. They will use their knowledge and skills of the 'four rules' and will apply these skills in problem-solving activities. The children will be engaging in lots of games and challenges that will further their thinking in maths.

# Class 2 Summer Term 2025

Class 2 have another exciting summer term ahead!  
For our whole school topic day this term, we will be celebrating the 80<sup>th</sup> anniversary of VE Day.  
Our whole school topic week this term is 'Healthy Eating'.

## Art and Design

In art and design, the children will be creating landscapes and cityscapes. The children will be recreating famous artists' work.

## PSHE

Our topics this term are 'Relationships' and 'Changing Me'.

## Science

In science, our topic this term is 'Plants'. In this topic, the children will explore the life cycles of various plants that grow from seeds and bulbs and investigate how they change as they grow and develop.

## History

Our topic for history is Seaside Holidays. The children will be learning what holidays were like in the past, with a focus on the Victorian seaside holidays, and the development of transport during that era.

## Design and Technology

In D&T, the children will design and create a functional Ferris wheel, they will learn how different components fit together so that the wheel rotates and the structure stands freely. In our cookery topic, the children will learn where fruit and vegetables grow and will design a fruit and vegetable smoothie with accompanying packaging.

## How you can help

Please continue to read and share books with your child every day, when possible. Spellings (for year 2) and keywords will be assessed each week so please can you help your child learn them. The keywords are tricky words that the children will need to learn by sight, so regular practice will help them become fluent in reading them.

We ask that you help your child with learning to tell the time and offer them experiences with money.
