

English

In English, the children will be exploring descriptive writing. The children will be using the 'Talk for Writing' approach. They will continue to read a range of interesting texts in guided reading sessions.

Religious Education

During this term, the children will focus on two key questions: 'What do Christians believe God is like?' and 'Why does Christmas matter to Christians?'

Physical Education

The children will have Adriano for P.E on a Wednesday and Miss Roberts on a Friday. They will be focusing on gymnastics, dance, and coordination skills.

Geography

Our topic this term will be 'The Four Seasons'. The children will find out how the seasons are linked with the month of the year. Then find out what the weather is like during each season.

Computing

The children will continue to learn about online safety and will learn the skills associated with painting pictures on an iPad. They will explore changing brush style and size; changing colours; drawing shapes and filling them; and adding text.

Music

In music, the children will be exploring the topics 'Colonel Hathi's March' and 'Cat and Mouse'.

Mathematics

In maths, the children will develop their knowledge of place value (Year 1 within numbers to 50 and Year 2 within numbers to 100), addition and subtraction, and multiplication. The children will be engaging in lots of games and challenges that will further their thinking in maths.

Art and Design

In art and design, our topic will be 'Formal Elements of Art'. The children will be looking at shape, line and colour.

In D&T, the children will be exploring textiles by designing and creating fabric faces. They will explore and become familiar with the names of different fabrics and learn how to choose and manipulate fabrics to create different effects; they will also learn how to join fabrics in a variety of ways.

Please continue to read and share books with your child every day, when possible. Spellings and keywords will be assessed each week so please can you help your child learn them. The keywords are tricky words that the children will need to learn by sight, so regular practice will help them become fluent in reading them. We ask that you help your child with learning to tell the time and offer them experiences with money.
