

## English

In English, the children will be exploring poetry, writing their own poems based upon colours. They will also be writing a letter, exploring persuasive techniques. The children will be using the 'Talk for Writing' approach.

## Religious Education

RE this term will be looking at the Christian belief of how the world was made. In the second half of the term, we will be learning how we should care for the world and others.

## Physical Education

Our PE topics this term are send and return, run, jump and throw, attack, shoot and defend and hit, catch and run.

## Art and Design

This term in Art and Design we are going to be working on portraiture. The children will have the opportunity to look at different artists, exploring fine art and abstract art skills.

## Geography

During the term the children will be learning about the World. They will be locating Europe on a world map and identifying some of its countries and features. They will also be locating Africa on a world map and exploring the features and characteristics of Kenya.

## PSHE

Our topic this term is economic wellbeing and at the end of term they will look at transition.

## Music

In music, the children will be exploring call-and-response, echo singing and playing, playing percussion, developing beat skills.

## Mathematics

In Maths, the children will develop their understanding of Money, Fractions, time and mass, capacity and temperature. They will apply their knowledge and skills of the 'four operations' and use these skills in problem-solving activities. The children will be engaging in practical activities that will further their mathematical thinking.

Our whole school topic this term is

## Science

In science, our topics this term is 'Plants'. In this topic, the children will observe, identify, compare, classify and describe UK plants. They will become familiar with different types of plants, including wild plants, garden plants and trees. They will also be encouraged to observe how plants change over time.

## History

In the first half of the term, we are going to be looking at Explorers. We will be exploring historical explorers such as Amelia Earhart and Christopher Columbus, as well as referencing some recent and local explorers.

## Computing

We will be looking at digital music; they will use different online programs to have a go at creating their own music. Experimenting with patterns and recording data.

## How you can help

Please continue to read and share books with your child every day, when possible. Keywords will be assessed each week so please can you help your child learn them. The keywords are tricky words that the children will need to learn by sight, so regular practice will help them become fluent in reading them. We ask that you help your child with learning to tell the time and offer them experiences with money.
