Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope everyone had a lovely Easter break. It's been lovely seeing the children return and hearing all about their adventures during the holidays!

The attached topic overview for the term outlines all the areas we will be focusing on between now and the end of the year and may provide inspiration for ways in which you would be able to enhance your child's learning outside of school and questions you may be able to ask your child about their learning.

We will be returning to Hay festival in May, which you will be receiving further information in due course.

P.E. will continue to be on a Wednesday and Thursday so children will need to come to school in P.E. kit on those days. Please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather. Obviously, this is (hopefully!) likely to get much hotter over the next few weeks. This should include trainers, plain black or navy joggers/shorts, a white t-shirt and a black or navy jumper.

We would like to encourage all children to bring a named water bottle which can be refilled at break times.

It is essential children continue to read from a wide range of material including fiction, non-fiction and poetry. They should be reading at home at least 4 times weekly, which they can record themselves, as well as regular TTRS and SpellingShed sessions – all login details should be printed inside the front cover of their reading diary. You should also find their spelling homework in their homework book on a weekly basis.
